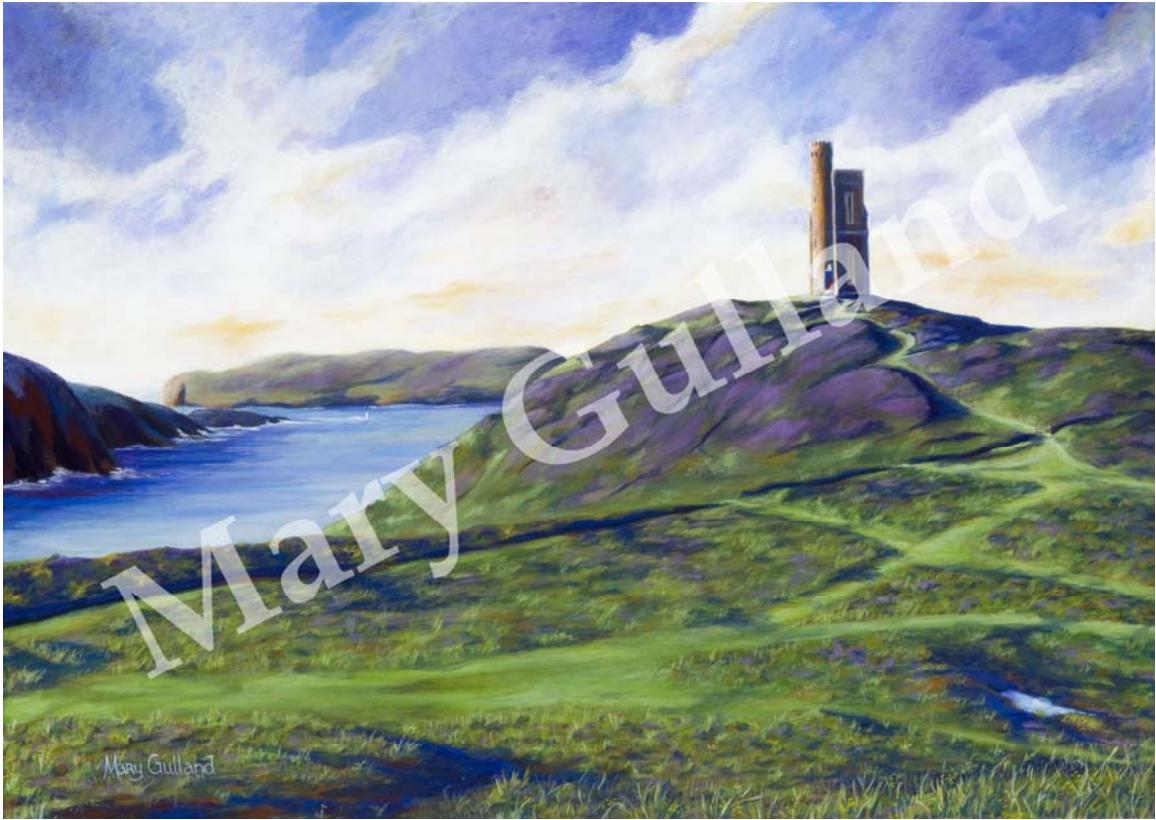


Port St Mary Inner Harbour (yellow boat)
